

What God Says About

The Kidneys

Ps 107:20

“He sends forth His word and heals them and rescues them from the pit and destruction.”

Psalms 26:2 Examine me, O LORD, and prove me; try my reins and my heart.

Hebrew – “reins” kilyah (kil-yaw') a kidney (as an essential organ); figuratively the mind kidneys, reins.

Hebrew – “try” tsaraph (tsaw-raf') refine pure, purge away, try.

Psalms 139:13 For thou hast possessed my reins: thou hast covered me in my mother's womb.

Hebrew – “possessed” qanah (kaw-naw') to own

Proverbs 23:16 Yea, my reins shall rejoice, when thy lips speak right things.

Isaiah 11:5 And righteousness shall be the girdle of his loins, and faithfulness the girdle of his reins.

Hebrew – “faithfulness” 'emunah 'emunah (em-oo-naw', em-oo-naw') literally firmness; figuratively security; stability, steady,

Hebrew – “girdle” 'ezor (ay-zore') ; a belt, also a band: (that which is wrapped around)
