Pets And Animals

Prov 12:10 The godly are concerned for the welfare of their animals, but even the kindness of the wicked is cruel. (NLT)

Gen 6:19 Bring a pair of every kind of animal — a male and a female — into the boat with you to keep them alive during the flood. 20 Pairs of each kind of bird and each kind of animal, large and small alike, will come to you to be kept alive. 21 And remember, take enough food for your family and for all the animals." (NLT)

Gen 9:2 All the wild animals, large and small, and all the birds and fish will be afraid of you. I have placed them in your power. (NLT)

Ex 9:4 But the LORD will make a distinction between the livestock of Israel and that of Egypt, so that no animal belonging to the Israelites will die." 5 The LORD set a time and said, "Tomorrow the LORD will do this in the land." 6 And the next day the LORD did it: All the livestock of the Egyptians died, but not one animal belonging to the Israelites died. 7 Pharaoh sent men to investigate and found that not even one of the animals of the Israelites had died. (NIV)

Psa 36:5 O LORD, your mercy reaches to the heavens, your faithfulness to the skies. 6 Your righteousness is like the mountains of God, your judgments like the deep ocean. You save people and animals, O LORD. (GW)

Ps 50:10 0 For all the animals of the forest are mine, and I own the cattle on a thousand hills. 11 Every bird of the mountains and all the animals of the field belong to me. (NLT)

The Superiority Of The New Covenant Promises

Heb 8:6 But our High Priest has been given a ministry that is far superior to the ministry of those who serve under the old laws, for he is the one who guarantees for us a better covenant with God, based on better promises. (NLT)

Heb 7:21 Only to Jesus did he say, "The Lord has taken an oath and will not break his vow: 'You are a priest forever.' " 22 Because of God's oath, it is Jesus who guarantees the effectiveness of this better covenant. (NLT)
